

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

Projet REM s.e.c hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* and its description.

Pursuant to paragraphs 4.1 et 9.1 of the said Act, Projet REM s.e.c. has deposited with the Minister of Transport on the online Common Project Search (<https://common-project-search.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 2624, a description of the following work and its site:

Reconstruction of the existing railway bridge for the Thousand Islands River crossing between the cities of Laval and Deux-Montagnes – Catenary removal.

This notice is aimed exclusively at the removal of the catenary and support poles currently installed on the railway bridge of the Thousand Islands River crossing. The catenary is used to power the Exo6 - Deux-Montagnes commuter rail line operated by Exo. Dismantling the catenary is required prior to the demolition and reconstruction of the railway bridge as part of the Réseau express métropolitain (REM) Project for the Deux-Montagnes segment.

This work will be carried out exclusively over the existing railway bridge.
