

26 stations, 67 km


A station in Griffintown



Zone 1: Rehabilitation of the southbound overpass



- Work required under the tracks to ensure the structure's integrity
- In progress: Saint-Paul, Notre-Dame and Saint-Jacques streets
- ⇒ Work performed during the week until the end of the year



William Street

Zone 1: Track upgrades on the southbound overpass



- Done: Removal of the infrastructure
- In progress: Waterproofing of the overpass and preparatory work for the new infrastructure
- Upcoming: Start of the installation of the new railway infrastructure

 \Rightarrow Day and <u>night</u> work






Griffintown–Bernard-Landry station **REM's elevated structure Control tower** Existing railway tracks Southbound overpass De la Commune bridge Peel Basin

Zone 2: Widening of De la Commune railway bridge

- **Done**: Construction of pillars
- In progress: Reconstruction of the bridge abutments
- Upcoming: Deck construction
- \Rightarrow Work carried out mostly by day



Zone 3: Smith Street embankment development


- In progress: Construction of a pillar and installation of part of the drainage system
- Upcoming: Installation of beams, retaining walls and catenary pole foundations
- \Rightarrow Day and <u>night</u> work
