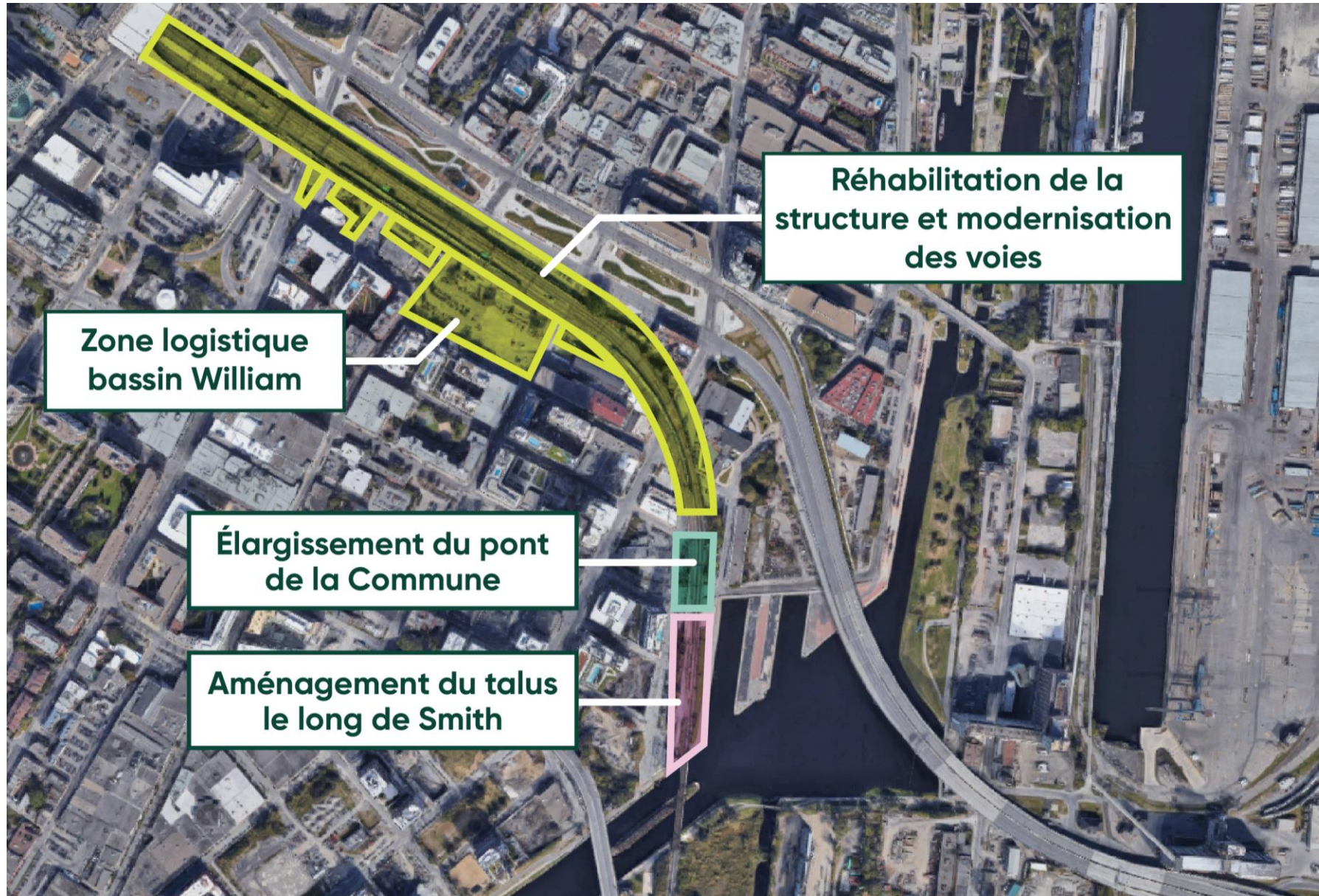

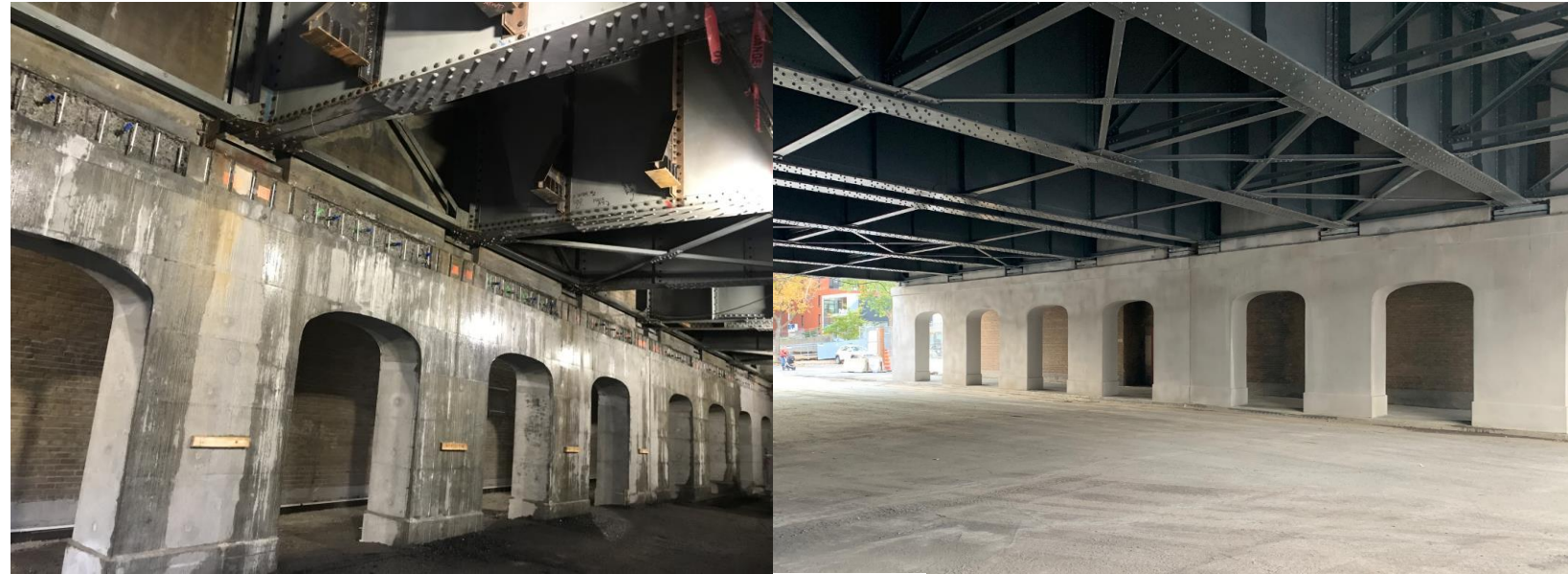

Zone 1: Rehabilitation of the southbound overpass

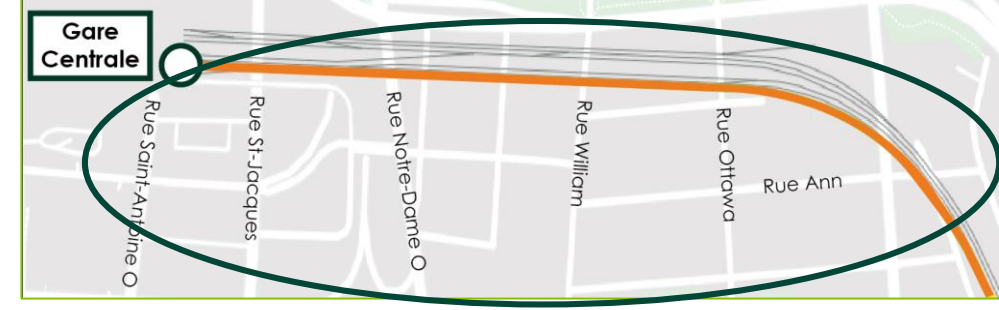


- Work required under the tracks to ensure the structure's integrity
- **In progress:** Saint-Paul, Notre-Dame and Saint-Jacques streets
- ⇒ Work performed during the week until the end of the year

Zone 1: Track upgrades on the southbound overpass



- **Done:** Removal of the infrastructure
 - **In progress:** Waterproofing of the overpass and preparatory work for the new infrastructure
 - **Upcoming:** Start of the installation of the new railway infrastructure
- ⇒ Day and night work

Zone 2: Widening of De la Commune railway bridge

- **Done:** Construction of pillars
 - **In progress:** Reconstruction of the bridge abutments
 - **Upcoming:** Deck construction
- ⇒ Work carried out mostly by day

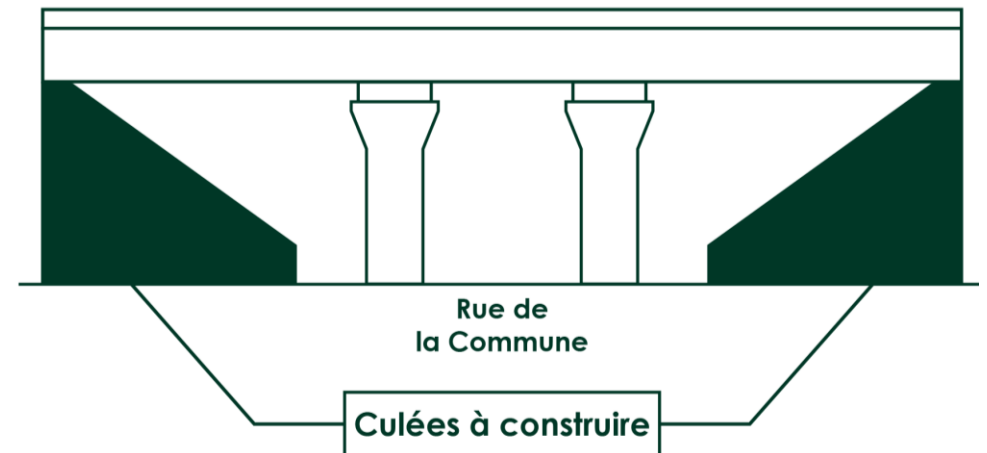
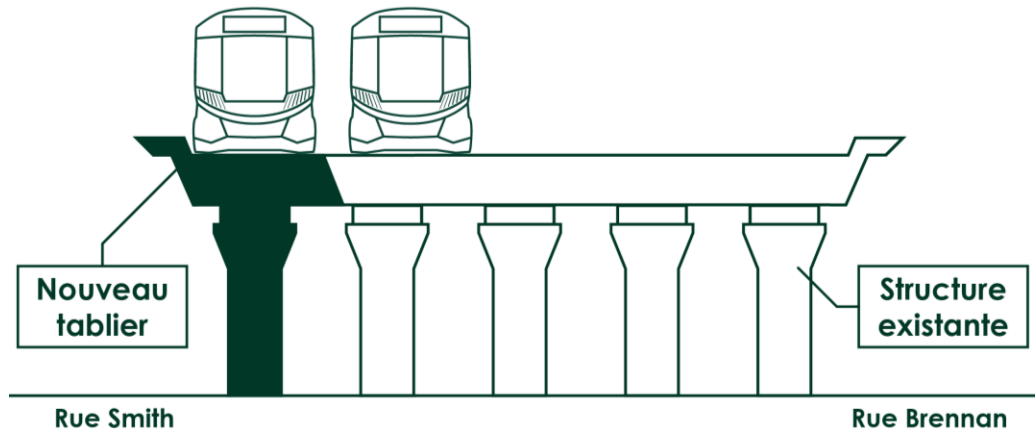

Zone 3: Smith Street embankment development

- **In progress:** Construction of a pillar and installation of part of the drainage system
 - **Upcoming:** Installation of beams, retaining walls and catenary pole foundations
- ⇒ Day and night work
