

CONTEST RULES

“First On Board ”

Participant identification. For the purposes of these Contest Rules, a participant is the person whose name appears on the Entry Form and will be awarded the prize if declared a winner.

Organizer identification. The contest is held by CDPQ Infra (the “Contest Organizers”) and will run from April 20, 2026, at 08:00:01 (ET) until 11:59:01 (ET) on April 26, 2026 (the “Contest Period”).

1. ELIGIBILITY

The contest is open to anyone who:

- Resides in Quebec
- Has reached the age of majority in the Province of Quebec (18+)

However, the following are not eligible: employees, representatives and agents of the Contest Organizers or any company, corporation, trust or other legal entity controlled by or related to them, their advertising and promotional agencies, suppliers of equipment and services related to this contest, and their immediate family members (brothers, sisters, children, father, mother), their legal or common-law spouse and all persons living with such employees, representatives and agents.

2. HOW TO ENTER

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. To enter, a participant must :

- Access the form, available on the REM website and distributed publicly via our social networks (Facebook, X and Instagram), as well as by newsletter.
- Enter the contact information as requested: last name, first name, email address and telephone number.
- Correctly answer the mathematical skill-testing question on the entry form.
- Declare that you have read and agree to the Contest Rules by checking the corresponding box.
- Click “Submit my entry”.

3. ENTRY RESTRICTIONS

Participants must adhere to the following, failing which they may be disqualified:

- Limit of one (1) entry per email address;
- Use of only one email address per participant when a participant has more than one;
- Limit of one prize per person and per residence.

4. PRIZES

The aggregate total approximate retail value (ARV) of all prizes offered is \$3,500.

5. DRAW

Random drawing of the Prizes will take on April 27, 2026, at the offices of Oxygène, the agency mandated by the Contest Organizers, located at 4330 Papineau Avenue, Montréal, Québec, H2H 1S9. The odds of winning a prize depend on the number of entries in the contest.

A maximum of 50 winners of the “First on Board” Prize will be selected to take part in the first public REM ride on the segment between the Anse-à-l’Orme and Des Sources stations.

6. CLAIMING PRIZES

To be declared a winner, a participant must:

- **Correctly answer** the mathematical skill-testing question on the entry form;
- **Reply to the Contest Organizers’ email** within five (5) days of receiving the email sent during the week following the closing of the online contest;
- **Complete and sign** the Liability Form sent by email by the Contest Organizers, stating that the winner has satisfied all the conditions outlined herein and return it to the Contest Organizers within five (5) days of receipt;
- **Be included on the winners list and receive the reminder email** with full details two weeks after the draw;
- **Where applicable, provide**, upon request and in a timely manner, one piece of photo ID.

Failure to satisfy any of the above conditions will result in the selected participant being disqualified and deemed to have forfeited his or her prize.

7. GENERAL CONDITIONS

Age of participation and companion. Entry is open to anyone 18 years of age or older at the time of entry. The prizes, consisting of pairs of tickets, will allow the winner to be accompanied by a person of his or her choice, who may be under 18 years of age. Should the participant be accompanied, the participant agrees to provide the Contest Organizers with the companion’s first and last names.

Acceptance of prize. The Prize must be accepted as described herein. In no event can it be, wholly or partially, subject to change requests or negotiations, transferred to another person or exchanged for another prize or money.

Verification. The contest entry documents and Liability Forms are subject to verification by the Contest Organizers. Any document that is either incomplete, illegible, mutilated, fraudulent, or registered or transmitted late, contains an invalid email address or telephone number, does not contain the correct answer to the mathematical skill-testing question or otherwise fails to meet the Contest Rules, may be rejected and will not qualify for either an entry or a prize.

Disqualification. The Contest Organizers reserve the right to disqualify any person or cancel one or more entries of a person if they participate or attempt to participate in this contest by any means that is contrary to these Contest Rules or is unfair to the other participants (e.g. entries beyond the allowable limit).

Harming the contest. Any attempt to deliberately damage the contest entry form or any associated website or to sabotage the legitimate conduct of the contest constitutes a violation of civil and criminal laws. Should any such attempt be made, the Contest Organizers reserve the right to reject the participant's entries and seek redress under law.

Website operation. The Contest Organizers do not guarantee in any way that the contest entry form or any website associated with the contest will be accessible or functional uninterruptedly during the Contest Period or that it will be free from error.

Limitation of liability – Participant. By entering or attempting to enter this contest, a participant releases the Contest Organizers, any company, corporation, trust or other legal entity controlled by or related to them, their advertising and promotional agencies, their employees, representatives and agents (the "Beneficiaries") from any liability for any damage that he or she may suffer as a result of accepting or using the prize, any delay in delivery, loss or theft of prizes, including from time to time and in connection with their remittance, and any liability or damage that he or she may suffer as a result of participating or attempting to participate in the Contest.

Limit of liability – Contest Organizers. Changes to the contest. The Contest Organizers reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the contest in whole or in part should an event or human intervention occur that may affect or influence the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the contest or the events included in the contest as provided herein.
